A Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Eldon No. 171 of Saskatchewan.

Any person who carries on the business of a direct seller within the Bural Municipality of Eldon No. 471 shall pay to the said Municipality the fee prescribed by the regulations under the Direct Sellers Act.

REGULATIONS UNDER THE DIRECT STITLES ACT, 1965

Applicants for Licence

1. A licence may, in the absolute discretion of the registrar, be refused to any person who has not been a resident of baskatchewan for at least one year immediately prior to the date of epplication.

- (4) A licence that authorizes the sale of photographs, fors or for coats shall be in Division D.
 (5) A licence that authorizes the sale of fruit, vegetables or meat shall be in Division C.
- (6) A licence that authorizes the sale of other pends or services shall be in Division B. unless otherwise provided in subsection (7).
 - (7)—(i) A Econee that authorizes the sale of books of an educational nature shall be in Division A.
 - (ii) A licence that authorizes the sale of goods or services where the registrar is satisfied that the amount of sale or sales to any one customer does not ordinarily exceed \$100.00 shall be in Division A.
- 5. Notwithstanding section 4, where the holder of a licence is a merchant selling in a munipality in which he has a recognized place of business in respect of which he pass a business tax of is a bona fade servant or employee of the men bout, the fee payable to the momentality shall be \$5.00
- 6. Where a person was the holder of a licence under the Commercial Agents Act, 1958, immediately prior to the commin into force of the Direct Sellers Act, 1965, such person shall be entitled to have any ficence fee or manicipal fee paid in respected such licence apply to the licence fee or municipal fee payable under these regulations for the licence period expiring on March 31, 1966.
